

Call for Participation

The International Conference: "Air and Water Quality Control: Important Factors in Protecting Human Health and Premises for Sustainable Development" will be held on July 4-5, 2024, at the Academy of Sciences of Albania.

This second international conference on Environmental Health, organized by the Academy of Sciences of Albania in collaboration with George Mason University, VA, USA, will focus this year on the theme: "Air and Water Quality Control: Important Factors in Protecting Human Health and Premises for Sustainable Development."

Air and water quality are two significant factors that determine the health of a population. Air pollutants such as NO_x, SO₂, O₃, and especially suspended particles are known to damage the environment and human health. Cardiovascular, cerebral, and lung health have been proven to depend on air quality. Similarly, water quality is essential for human health. Our country is fortunate from a natural point of view because it has rich water resources. However, waste disposal sites' often inadequate and unsuitable infrastructure requires quality, responsibility, and continuous monitoring. Therefore, water and air quality controls are crucial in preventing or minimizing health and environmental hazards. Scientific research in these fields is fundamental to knowing our country's situation and exchanging experiences with countries with advanced scientific research.

The international conference of June 28-30, 2023, on "Environmental and Professional Health" organized by the Academy of Sciences of Albania in collaboration with George Mason University, USA, and Collegium "Ramazzini" was an essential and successful experience to continue further scientific collaborative activity in the fields of Public Health.

With the proposal of Professor Melissa J. Perry, Dean of the School of Public Health at George Mason University, VA, USA, the Academy of Sciences of Albania is organizing a second international conference in the field of Environmental Health with the theme "Air and Water Quality Control: Important Factors in Protecting Human Health and Premises for Sustainable Development."

The conference will be held on July 4-5, 2024 with international participation and the publication of an ISBN-registered book with the presented papers is being discussed.
